INSTALLATION:GUIDE


The **SR.HydroPex**[™] panels manufactured by Styro Rail[™] are composed of type 2 [200 series] expanded polystyrene [EPS] rigid insulation or type 3 [300 to 600 series]. A honeycomb-layout creates a spacing with intervals of 762 mm [3"] for the placement of the pipes. The system is compatible with all pipes dimensions: 13 mm [1/2"], 16 mm [5/8"], 20 mm [3/4"] and 25 mm [1"].

RECOMMENDED USE

Install **SR.HydroPex**[™] panels as a insulating material that offers a support to fix water or glycol radiant heat floor pipes. Install 200 series prior to the pouring of finished concrete of basement slabs and residential garages; 300 to 600 series for commercial, industrial and agricultural concrete slabs.

- ▲ Expanded Polystyrene Rigid Insulation Panel [EPS] type 2 or type 3 molded by Styro Rail™
- **B** 19 mm [3/4"] Overlap on 4 sides
- **C** Dome
- Honeycomb Layout





PANEL INSTALLATION 152 mm [6"] min.




GENERAL INSTALLATION

- 1 Compact the back fill material.
- 2 Install a vapour barrier on the footings and over the back fill material.
- **3** Leave a vapour barrier strip at the bottom of the foundation wall. Leave a minimum of 152 mm [6"] over the concrete slab.
- **4** Apply an acoustic sealant bead between vapour barrier and foundation wall. Press firmly on the vapour barrier.
- **5** Begin the installation on an interior corner of the foundation.
- **6** Using a knife with a retractable blade, cut ship laps that will butt against the wall.
- **7** Install the **SR.HydroPex**[™] panel on the vapour barrier. Butt ends between panels. Install panels continuously and uniformly.
- 8 Continue installation by overlapping joints.
- 9 Align domes between panels.
- **10** Follow the steps described in this present guide to install the panels and the pipes.
- 11 Pour the concrete slab.


FINISHING SLAB [BASEMENT]


- 1 Install a type 2 expanded polystyrene strip of minimum 50 mm [2"]* in thickness on the vertical section of the vapor barrier.
- **2** Calculate the height of the expanded polystyrene strip with the thickness of the $\mathbf{SR.HydroPex}^{TM}$ panel and the concrete slab
- 3 Install panels as described in this guide.


* The expanded polystyrene strip can be reduced to 32 mm [1-1/4"] for the basement finishing slabs that does not contain ducts, heating pipe system or buried cables and that are located at least at 610 mm [24"] under the soil level.

> PIPE


1 Insert pipes between domes depending on the configuration and space required by the installer or according to plans and specifications.


REBAR


- **2** When rebars are required, insert $Prolok^{\circledast}$ fasteners in the hollow part of the honeycomb layout. Allow for the spacing indicated in the plans and specifications or as per the spacing recommended by the ties manufacturer.
- **3** Insert *Prolok®* fasteners after pipes installation.
- 4 Insert rebars into *Prolok®* fasteners.
- **5** Pour the concrete slab.



JUNCTION DETAILS









> OPENINGS AND PIPING

- **1** Seal the perimeter of the object using a vapour barrier tape.
- **2** Using a knife with a retractable blade or a drywall saw, cut panel on object perimeter.
- **3** Install **SR.HydroPex**™ panel through the object.



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GENERAL ADVICES

STORAGE AND COVERING

Store panels in a dry location, protected from the outside elements, ultraviolet rays, open flames or other sources of ignition. Stack panels on pallets of minimum 100 mm [4"] above the ground. If provided packaging has been damaged during shipping, cover panels with a weather and ultraviolet tarp. Panels must be dry and in good condition before installation.
