SR. DRAIN

EXPANDED POLYSTYRENE RIGID INSULATION FOR VERTICAL SURFACE DRAINAGE


The SR.Drain[™] panels manufactured by Styro Rail[™] are composed of type 2 [200 series] or type 3 [300 to 600 series] expanded polystyrene [EPS] rigid insulation. They comprise of a smooth surface and a surface with grooves allowing water to drain downwards.

RECOMMENDED USE


Install SR.Drain™ panels on the exterior surface of the foundation walls, the channeled surface on the interior side, towards the foundation wall, in order to obtain a continuous insulation of the wall and enhancing the effectiveness of a waterproofing system. The draining grooves contribute to channeling sub-surface water away and preventing the built-up of hydrostatic pressure against the structure. The type 3 SR.Drain™ panels are ideal for prolonged groundwater contact applications; with the lowest water absorption rate of the three available EPS types.

PANEL COMPOSITION

- A Type 2 or Type 3 Expanded Polystyrene Rigid Panel Insulation [EPS] manufactured by Styro Rail™
- **B** Draining grooves








GENERAL INSTALLATION

- 1 Using the flat surface of a hammer; scratched the surface of the concrete wall to remove concrete bumps.
- Install a waterproofing membrane on the concrete wall. Install as specified by the manufacturer.
- 3 Install SR.Drain[™] panels vertically on the full height of the wall, the draining grooves toward the foundation wall.
- 4 Install panels left to right. Install panels continuously and uniformaly. Butt ends between panels.
- 5 Fix panels using corrosion-resistant screws or insulation nails^{††} ensuring a penetration in the concrete wall with a minimum of 38 mm [1-½"]. Use screws with plastic washers of minimum 25 mm [1"] in diameter.
- 6 Fix panels by allowing a spacing of maximum 610 mm [24"] between screws.
- 7 Fix the screws at approximately 51 mm [2"] from the edges.
- 8 As necessary, pre-drill the foundation wall with an impact drill.
- 9 Backfill the foundation.
- 10 Install an exterior finish coating on the exposed section of the insulating panels.
- 11 At inside and outside corners, cut off the ship lap to ensure a continuous joint between the panels.




GENERAL FIXATION

- 1 For foundation backfilled at approximately 305 mm [12"], fix the first row of screws at approximately 51 mm [2"] of the edges.
- 2 Allow a spacing of maximum 610 mm [24"] between the fixations.
- 3 Install a few screws on the on the remaining surface of the panel to maintain in place until the backfill.
- 4 Backfill the foundation at approximately 305 mm [12"]. The soil weight will maintain the panels in place.

EXTERIOR FINISH

- 5 Install a flashing on the foundation.
- **6** Exceed the flashing over the insulating panels and the exterior finish coating.
- 7 Install an exterior finish coating such as stucco.



PENETRATION[PIPE, DUCT, ETC.]

- Drill a hole for the openings using a concrete drill and with an appropriate size bit. Install duct before the installation of the waterproof membrane.
- If the membrane is in a roll format; cut a square shape piece of membrane with a cross shape slot. Insert the square shape piece on the duct.
- Install the membrane on the concrete wall. Install as specified by the manufacturer.
- 4 If the membrane is a liquid type; seal around the duct using a compatible sealant bead as specified by the manufacturer.
- 5 Cut the insulating panels using a drill with an appropriate diameter bit or with a gypsum saw. Adjust the cut to gross openings of the pipes.
- 6 Install the insulating panels as per the installation method described in this guide.
- 7 Seal around the pipe using a compatible sprayed urethane bead[†].

GENERAL ADVICES

RECOMMENDED PRODUCTS

[†] Sealants must be compatible with expanded polystyrene. Use *ADFoam* from *ADFast* polyurethane insulating foam or equivalent.

^{††} Use nails for insulation fixation *XI-FV* from *Hilti* or equivalent.

STORAGE AND COVERING

Store panels in a dry and ventilated location, protected from the outside elements, ultraviolet rays, open flames or other sources of ignition. Stack panels on pallets of minimum 100 mm [4"] above the ground. If provided packaging has been damaged during shipping, cover panels with a weather and ultraviolet tarp. Panels must be dry and in good condition before installation.

Cover the panels within 60 days after installation with an exterior cladding protecting from ultraviolet rays.
